INFORMATION FROM THE FOOTHILLS AREA COMMAND

Commander Aaron Jones in the March newsletter cautions us to be wary of phishing scams during this tax period. Beware of emails, calls or texts pretending to be the IRS. The IRS never contacts taxpayers via phone, email, or text demanding payment. Monitor your accounts by regularly checking your bank and tax accounts for suspicious activity. Chief Harold Medina shares with us the information that during this first two months of this year, there has been a 40% decrease in auto thefts compared to the same time frame last year. He reiterates that there has been a recent uptick in thefts of specific Honda models in our Northeast and Foothills area.
