#### INFORMATION FROM THE FOOTHILLS AREA COMMAND

In the issue for May from our area substation, a message from Chief Medina mentions that APD is working in conjunction with a team of volunteers from Sandia National Labs on creating an innovative model to determine where to use surveillance cameras to combat crime. Based on 5 years of crime data, they have created a model that shows the City exactly where a camera should be placed, at what height, and at what direction to most effectively capture a crime on camera. The model also is assisting the City in modifying placement of existing cameras.

# ON THE HOMEFRONT
